#### **DESIGN & AESTHETICS**

SHAPE: Low growing, spreading  
LANDSCAPE USE: Low growing groundcover, turf replacement, urban landscape, erosion control  
FLOWER: Pink powderpuff flower, 1"-2" in size, spring through fall  
FRUIT: Small seed pods  
WILDLIFE: Bees, Little sulphur butterfly host plant  
PLANT DESCRIPTION: Low growing, spreading groundcover. Binately compound leaves with tiny leaflets which close up when touched. Pink puffball flowers extending above the groundcover.
