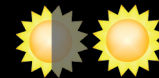


GROWTH & HABITAT

SIZE: 15' at maturity
USDA HARDINESS ZONE: 9b - 11
SOIL: well drained
SALT TOLERANCE: moderate
ORIGIN: Philippines, New Guinea

LIGHT:

Full Sun to Partial
Shade



MOISTURE:

Water to establish then,
Low, Drought Tolerant



DESIGN & AESTHETICS

SHAPE: Shrub or small standard tree with one or multiple trunks
LANDSCAPE USE: Accent shrub or tree with winter color
FLOWER: Pink and white clusters, winter blooming
FRUIT: insignificant, inedible berries
WILDLIFE: hummingbirds, butterflies, bees
PLANT DESCRIPTION: Medium to large shrub with multiple trunks, produces 'suckers' from the roots. Large leaves with green on the top and purple on the bottom. Used as a shrub or ornamental tree. Large showy blooms in winter.
