GROWTH & HABITAT

SIZE: around 1'-3' tall with just as much spread

USDA HARDINESS ZONE: 10-11

SOIL: well drained SALT TOLERANCE: high ORIGIN: Florida Native

DESIGN & AESTHETICS

SHAPE: spreading

LANDSCAPE USE: low groundcover, mass planting

FLOWER: small white to pink flower

FRUIT: small, round, yellow WILDLIFE: food for birds

PLANT DESCRIPTION: As a Florida Native the Golden Creeper (Beach Creeper) is a highly salt and drought tolerant groundcover. It is the perfect choice for coastal areas or areas with little or no irrigation. Be wary of overwatering as it can cause it to dieback.
