SIZE: 10'-12'

DESIGN & AESTHETICS

SHAPE: Upright small palm

LANDSCAPE USE: Small spaces, courtyards, accent palm, understory

FLOWER: Small white inflorescence

FRUIT: Egg shaped orange fruit, edible WILDLIFE: None

PLANT DESCRIPTION: Small palm with single trunk and no crown shaft. Teeth or spines are present on dark petioles, left as boots on the trunk. Dark green pinnate fronds with a feather look.
