



GROWTH & HABITAT

SIZE: 20'-30'

USDA HARDINESS ZONE: 10A-11

SOIL: Enriched sandy soil

SALT TOLERANCE: Low to Moderate

ORIGIN: Native to Central & South America

LIGHT:

Full Sun, Partial Shade



MOISTURE:

Moderate; tolerate long drought/ short periods of wet soil

SHAPE: Upright, taller than wide. Irregular trunk shape and growth habit.

LANDSCAPE USE: Accent tree, specimen tree, buffer tree

FLOWER: Showy yellow clusters

FRUIT: Seed pods

PLANT DESCRIPTION: Medium to large sized canopy tree. Gray, textured cork-like bark with irregular trunk shape and growth pattern. Deciduous, palmate compound leaves with silver underside color. Showy clusters of yellow flowers in spring.
